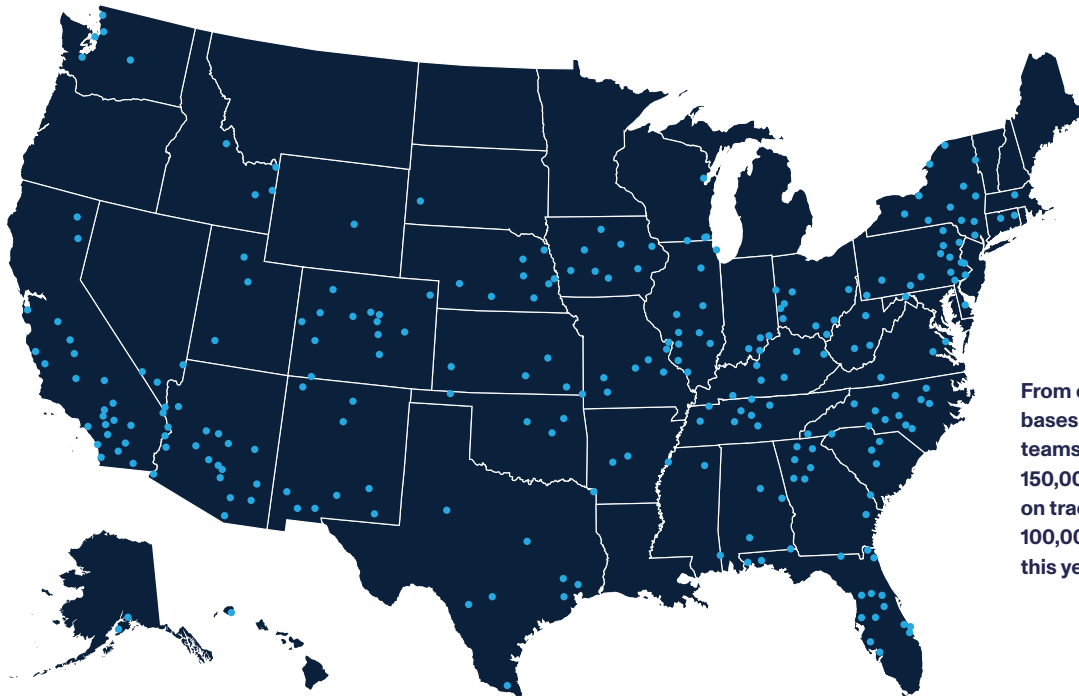

Daily Life

The standard medical crew configuration for Air Methods consists of a flight nurse and a flight paramedic, operating under the direction of a local medical director. As part of our commitment to provide air medical transport resources to our communities 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, most Air Methods flight teams work 24-hour shifts.

Resources

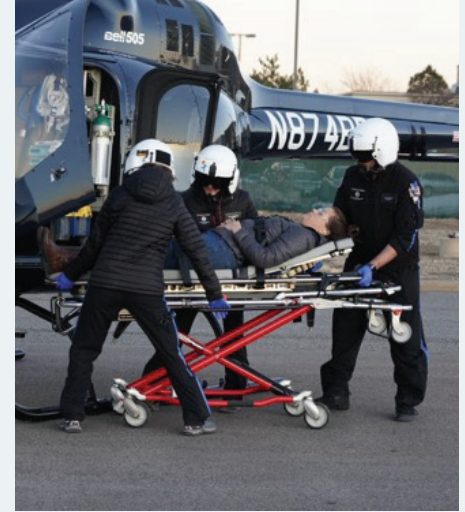

Air Methods supports them several ways: we provide state-of-the-art medical equipment, comprehensive training programs (including annual attendance at cadaver labs), and encourage training for professional growth and development.

Relationship Building

Another key component of working for Air Methods is the development of positive interpersonal relationships with your colleagues, EMS representatives, hospitals, and the community. Clinical teams can participate in non-transport activities to build relationships, including patient follow-up, educational activities provided to our professional partners, and various public relations events.

Become a Clinical Leader

Because of the scope of Air Methods' operations, flight nurses and flight paramedics are afforded many opportunities for relocation and upward mobility. If a flight nurse or flight paramedic is willing to relocate, they can choose from our 150 community bases across the United States. Additionally, qualified nurses and paramedics have the opportunity for promotion to a range of management roles, helping to support our operation through leadership.



Clinical Base Lead

Supervises daily operations of assigned base(s), coordinates local clinical team activities, assists management team in assuring the clinical team meets all company standards, and performs the required duties as an active flight crewmember.

Regional Clinical Director

Oversees clinical care, ensuring that it consistently meets or exceeds standard of care. Aids in goal setting, planning, problem solving, quality management, clinical education, organizing, leading, and communicating with staff. Helps management team in development, implementation, and enforcement of Air Methods' standards. Maintains accreditation and oversight of quality assurance/improvement program to ensure Air Methods meets its goals and objectives. Maintains the clinical qualifications of an active flight crewmember. Participates as a member of the regional leadership team.

Regional Clinical Educator

Oversees all initial and recurrent continuing education for medical crewmembers within their assigned region. Helps build activities at training centers, while maintaining the clinical qualifications of an active flight crewmember. Similar to the clinical director, works as member of the regional leadership team.



The Commission on Accreditation of Medical Transport Systems (CAMTS)

includes a voluntary audit every three years to establish that we meet and exceed industry-wide standards. These standards address not only the quality of patient care, education of medical personnel, and medical equipment, but also operational and safety concerns. We are proud that we consistently achieve CAMTS accreditation, as it is a mark of excellence for a critical care transport program.
